

**December 2015 Minutes

The Woodlawn Park City Council met on December 21, 2015, at Woodlawn Park City Hall. Larry Lewis stated he went to a meeting with the League of Cities. Google Fiber is interested in expanding into Louisville. They did not realize there are 82 suburban cities. They are asking the cities to form a pact so they do not have to go to each city. Larry is going to a meeting and will bring back information. Council can do a resolution to accept the proposal after their review. Google fiber will offer up to 1000 mgs and will charge \$130.00 for internet and TV. There will be 3 programs offered.

Larry passed out a State of the City Report to the Council.

**Drainage/Sanitation/Streetlights** George Langford stated there was 1 light out, which was called into LG&E.

He stated Eline had a survey and there is a 35 foot easement, which is an MSD easement. They will also paint the building. 4409 Kinloch had preciously requested a permit. The current owner has been given permission to complete the fence.
