

Special Meeting Minutes(corrected)  
of the Woodlawn Park City Council

The Woodlawn Park City Council met on October 30, 2017 at Woodlawn Park City Hall for a Special Meeting. Present were, Mayor Larry Lewis, Council Members, Doug Watson, Scott Horn George Langford and Tom Nunn and Shannon Seidt and City Clerk Chana Elswick. Absent were Council Member Greg Claypool, Treasurer Gloria Curran and Attorney Matt Carey.

The meeting stated at 7:00 pm.

Larry stated a quorum was present.

Larry stated the meeting was to consider the options for curbside leaf removal.

Adam with Brownsboro Lawncare reviewed the quotes. He has offered \$90.00 per hour with a \$50.00 dump fee, usually 4 dumps. He has also offered \$40.00 per ~~house~~,house with no dump fee. Tom asked about the timing. Adam stated it would take 7-8 days. It would take 1 week to do about half the City. Adam said he was thinking of doing it after Thanksgiving.

George stated he probably would not use the service.

Larry stated there was a 50% response to the email survey. He stated Gloria said there was about \$5000.00 in the contingency fund. If the bill went over, there would have to be an amendment to the budget. Council discussed the cost per house versus the full quote. Shannon discussed the percentage of houses that may participate. Scott stated the bill could still be over \$11000.00. Larry stated there was no personal advantage to him either way.

Shannon asked how prevalent backyard leaves versus front yard leaves. George asked why Adam doesn't put out the flyers instead of the city. It saves Adam money if the City does it. Scott stated he is concerned about advertising it and people not having it done in time. Larry stated the City could put out street signs.

Larry stated the issue could be put off for now and look at it in next year's budget. Scott is concerned about the advertising. He stated Adam has the opportunity to make \$17000.00. Shannon asked if Adam proposed it or if residents had asked for it. Doug stated that since it is not in the budget, it is a lot of money to put out. He stated his preference is, if we do a mailing, would Adam give the residents the \$40.00 rate. Tom stated that would be a lot more work for Adam. Tom stated he would like to table the discussion until the next budget.

Tom made a motion to table leaf removal for 2017 year and survey in anticipation of the 2018 budget item. Doug seconded the motion. All voted aye. Larry stated he will let Adam know the decision.

Doug made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Scott seconded the motion. All voted aye and the motion was passed. The meeting was adjourned at 7:30pm
